



Main functions:

- → Promoting and coordinating the information and digitalisation systems in the metropolitan area.

- **Early-stage work** done by UNDP:
 - completed a Water Network in the village
 - rehabilitated Hnaider water reservoir without success in delivering water to all the residents

- → Increase awareness and knowledge about the water and Syrian Refugees current situation in the area and illustrate the actions of the project.








